**ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR  
REHEARING OR REVIEW**

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8 At its public meeting on December 1, 2022, the Arizona Medical Board (“Board”)  
9 considered Scott M. Brannan, M.D.’s (“Respondent”) Motion for Review of the Board’s  
10 Order dated October 7, 2022 in the above referenced matter. Respondent was present  
11 and represented by Counsel, Adam Anderson, Esq. Board Respondent and his counsel  
12 provided statements to the Board. Board members noted that the Board’s order required  
13 participation in the Board’s Physician Health Program (“PHP”), which requires an order for  
14 probation in order to be effective and enforceable. Board members additionally noted the  
15 extensive nature of the Formal Hearing and the multiple acts of unprofessional conduct  
16 that were sustained. Board members noted that Respondent participated in an inpatient  
17 evaluation subsequent to the Formal Interview, and agreed that the evaluation supported  
18 continued participation in the PHP. After considering all of the evidence, the Board voted  
19 unanimously to deny Respondent’s Request for Rehearing or Review.

20 **ORDER**

21 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

22 Respondent’s Request for Rehearing or Review is denied. The Board’s October 7,  
23 2022 Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order for Decree of Censure and  
24 Probation in Case MD-17-1099A is effective and constitutes the Board’s final  
25 administrative order.
