**ORDER FOR SURRENDER  
OF LICENSE AND CONSENT  
TO THE SAME**

7 Rebecca A. Allison, M.D. ("Physician") elects to permanently waive any right to a  
8 hearing and appeal with respect to this Order for Surrender of License; admits the  
9 jurisdiction of the Arizona Medical Board ("Board") as well as the facts stated herein; and  
10 consents to the entry of this Order by the Board.

11 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

12 1. The Board is the duly constituted authority for the regulation and control of  
13 the practice of allopathic medicine in the State of Arizona.

14 2. Physician is the holder of license number 22942 for the practice of allopathic  
15 medicine in the State of Arizona.

16 3. The Board initiated case number MD-18-0254A after receiving a report  
17 indicating that Respondent may have a health condition that impacts her ability to safely  
18 practice medicine.

19 4. Effective April 11, 2018, Physician entered into an Interim Consent  
20 Agreement for a Practice Limitation.

21 5. Physician requests surrender of licensure.

22 6. There has been no finding of unprofessional conduct against Physician.

23 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

24 1. The Board possesses jurisdiction over the subject matter hereof and over  
25 Physician.



1           5. All admissions made by Physician are solely for final disposition of this  
2 matter and any subsequent related administrative proceedings or civil litigation involving  
3 the Board and Physician. Therefore, said admissions by Physician are not intended or  
4 made for any other use, such as in the context of another state or federal government  
5 regulatory agency proceeding, civil or criminal court proceeding, in the State of Arizona or  
6 any other state or federal court.

7           6. Upon signing this agreement, and returning this document (or a copy  
8 thereof) to the Board's Executive Director, Physician may not revoke the consent to the  
9 entry of the Order. Physician may not make any modifications to the document. Any  
10 modifications to this original document are ineffective and void unless mutually approved  
11 by the parties.

12           7. This Order is a public record that will be publicly disseminated as a formal  
13 non-disciplinary action of the Board and will be reported to the National Practitioner's Data  
14 Bank and on the Board's web site as a non-disciplinary action.

15           8. If the Board does not adopt this Order, Physician will not assert as a defense  
16 that the Board's consideration of the Order constitutes bias, prejudice, prejudgment or  
17 other similar defense.

18           9. ***Physician has read and understands the terms of this agreement.***


